Billions of Federal Aid Dollars for Texans are at Stake

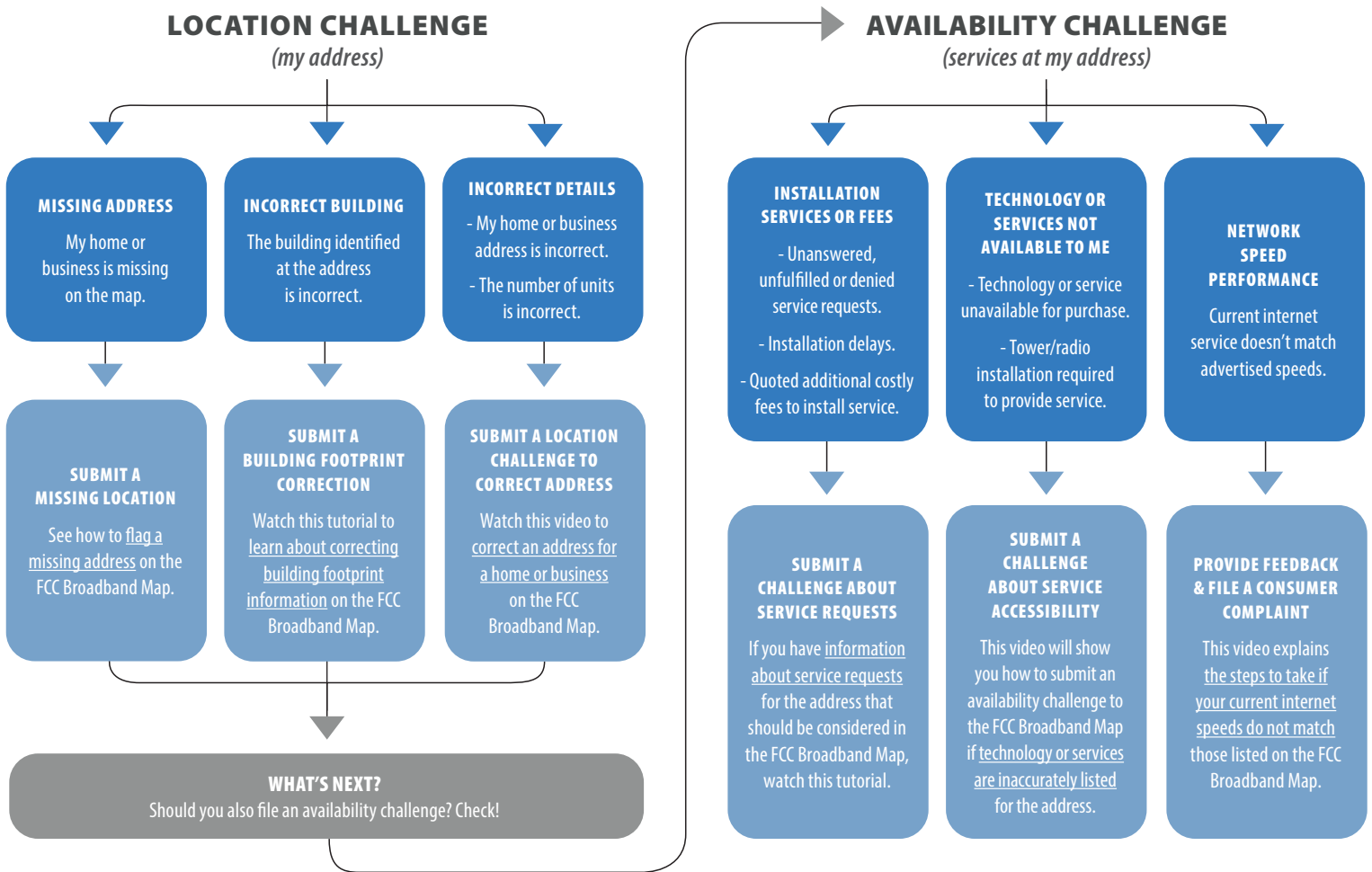
Texas' share of the \$42.5 billion allocated to expand broadband access will be determined by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) National Broadband Map. This map should detail where internet services are available, but it needs data from the most reliable source – you.

How to Help

You can help improve internet access in your community by challenging the FCC map. Look up your home or small business address on the map and check for inaccuracies.

GATHER EVIDENCE

Supporting documentation is not required but may help strengthen your challenge. Here are some examples.

Accepted file formats: DOC, DOCX, PDF, JPEG, PNG



LOCATION CHALLENGES

Google Maps screenshots; Zillow screenshots; photos of location; photos of business cards; lease agreements; utility bills; mail; floor plans



AVAILABILITY CHALLENGES

Explanation of previous interaction(s) with providers; screenshots of providers' website; images of the providers' marketing material; saved correspondence (such as email or chat session history) with providers
